MUNICIPAL JUDGE

This is a partial term to fill a vacancy through June of 2026, at which time the candidate may be eligible to be considered for appointment to a full two-year term.

Minimum requirements:

- Must have graduated from an accredited law school and been admitted to the practice of law before the courts of record in South Carolina with a minimum of five (5) years of experience as a practicing attorney and preferably at least two (2) years of municipal experience. Maintenance of annual Continuing Legal Education is required.
 - Must be in good standing with the South Carolina Supreme Court.
 - Must possess (or obtain) licensing through the South Carolina Court Administration within six (6) months of taking office.
 - Must obtain and maintain professional liability insurance.
 - Ability to be available during nights/weekends and holidays to render services as necessary.
- Ability to be generally available to attend mandatory meetings in person and/or on short notice and the ability to be reached promptly by phone.
